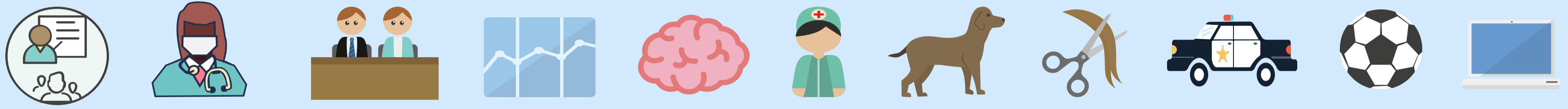
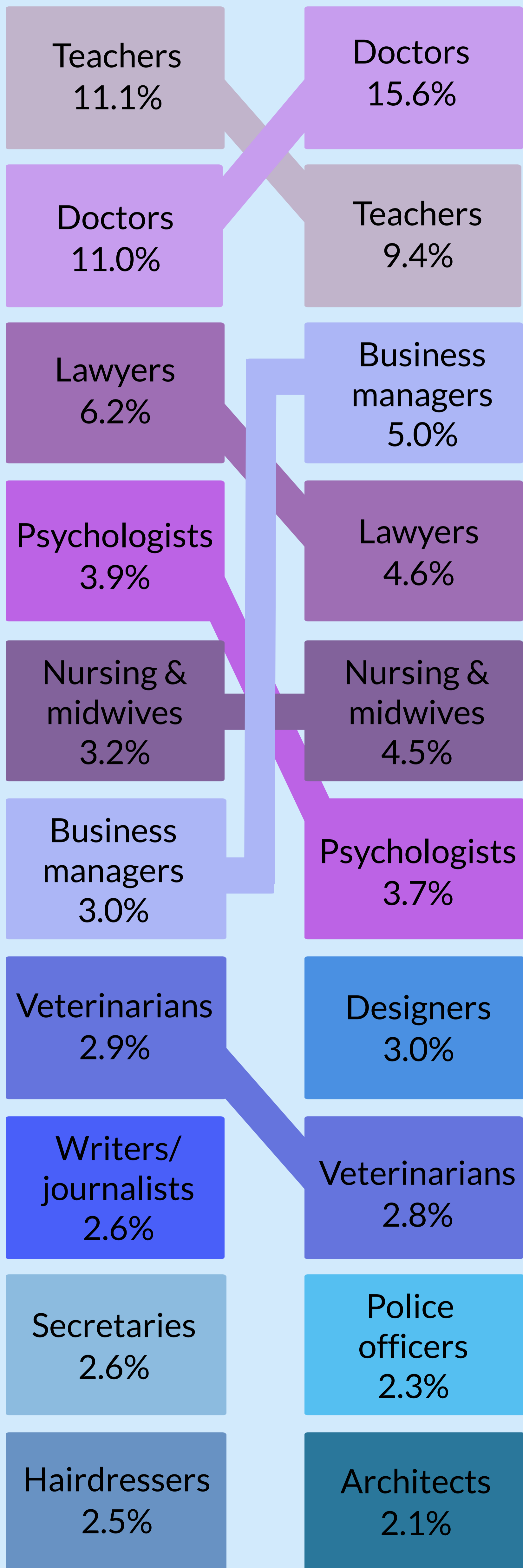


TEENAGE CAREER ASPIRATIONS OVER TIME

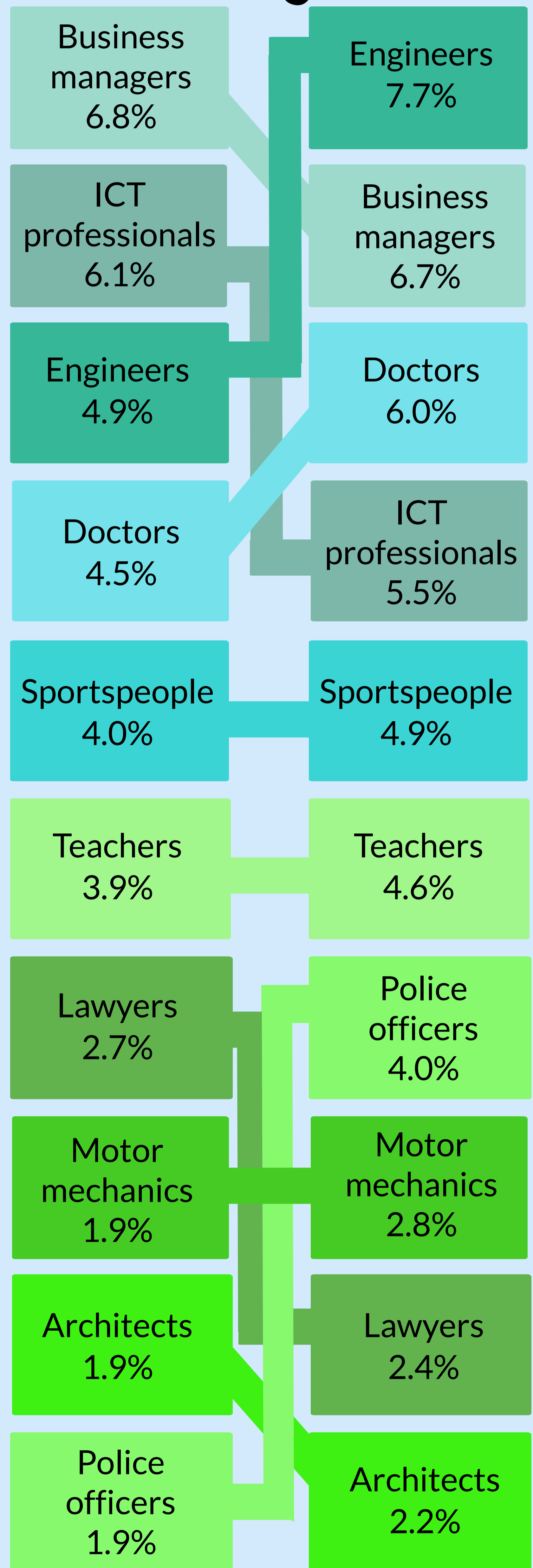
