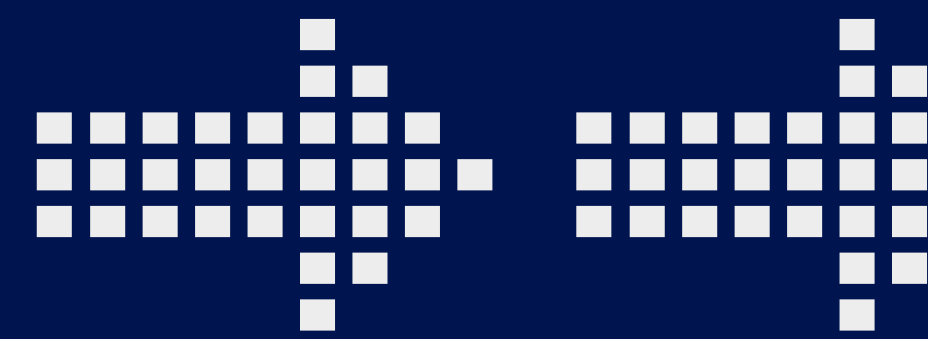


FROM ONE TEACHER TO ANOTHER
