
LANGUAGE AND COGNITIVE SKILLS

IN THE EARLY YEARS

The Australian Early Development Census (AEDC) measures the development and learning of around 300 000 children aged 0-5 across Australia across five domains: language and cognitive skills; communication and general knowledge; emotional maturity; social competence; and physical health and wellbeing. Results from the 2021 collection cycle show that the language and cognitive skills domain has seen the **most significant shift**.

Between 2018 and 2021, there has been an increase in the % of children classified as developmentally vulnerable in the language and cognitive skills domain for all equity groups identified by the AEDC.
