
## Classroom disciplinary climate global comparisons

The new country report *Education Policy Outlook in Australia* has highlighted the fact that 'The disciplinary climate in schools in Australia was among the least favourable in the OECD according to students' reports in PISA 2018'. In this infographic we take a look at those PISA survey statistics (from the findings on 'Disciplinary climate in language-of-instruction lessons'), and how Australia compares with 11 other countries.
