

ICT standards for teachers

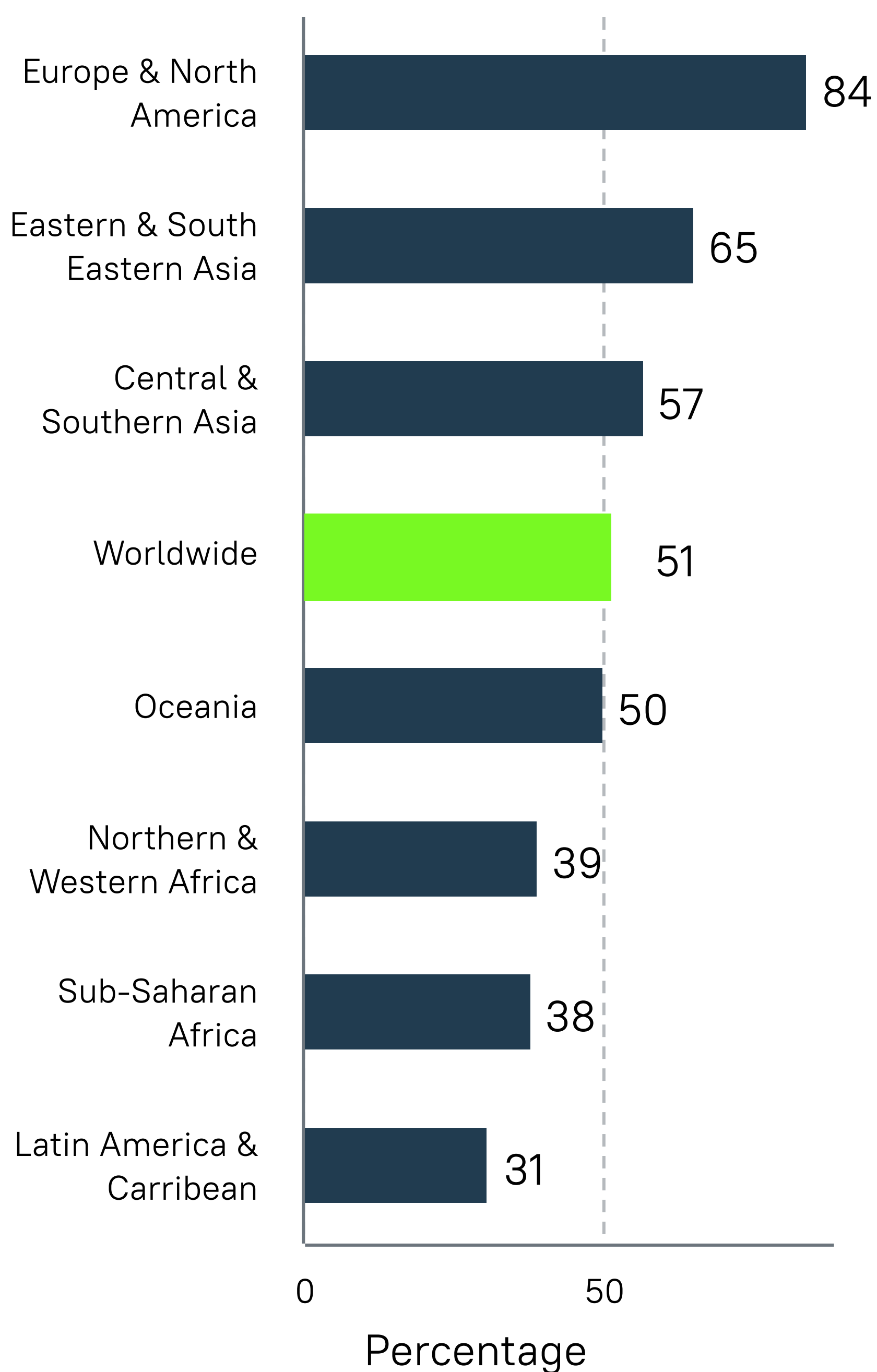
An international snapshot



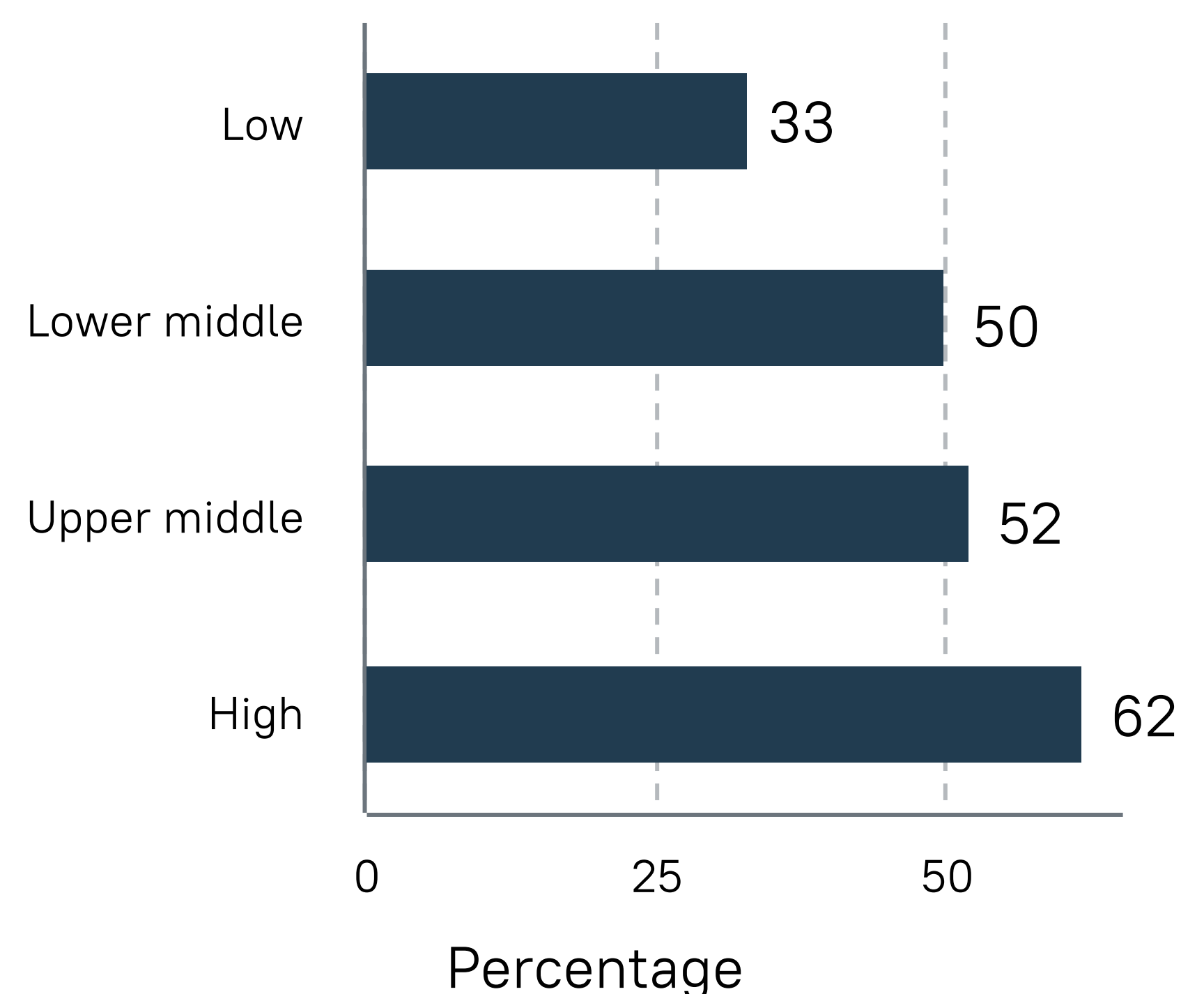
UNESCO's Global Education Monitoring (GEM) Report for 2023 focuses on technology in education, highlighting the benefits, opportunities and the challenges. According to the report's PEER (Profiles Enhancing Education Reviews) for 211 education systems, 51% have set ICT standards for teachers 'in a competency framework, teacher training framework, development plan or strategy'. Here is an international snapshot for 2022.

Worldwide, just over half of the countries (51%) have implemented standards, with European and Northern American countries the most proactive. The GEM Report estimates 1 in 5 countries specified or readjusted their ICT standards for teachers following the COVID-19 pandemic.
